AND WHEREAS, the assessed value of the whole land chargeable under this By-law, according to the last revised assessment roll, is \$117,246,370.00;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Town of Stonewall is \$3,040,628.67, of which no portion of the principal or of the interest thereon is in arrears;

- 1. That the Town of Stonewall may expand up to Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) for the purposes of the Project;
- 2. That the Town of Stonewall is hereby authorized and empowered to raise upon the credit of the municipality, funds not repayable within the current fiscal year by the

borrowing of money in an amount not exceeding One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

3. That the funds so raised shall be for the purpose of financing certain works as follows:

the construction of the Visitor Centre at Stonewall Quarry Park for the provision of interpretive, educational, community, performing and visual arts and administrative services and programs.

- 4. That borrowing for the aforesaid Project shall be issued by the Town of Stonewall in the Province of Manitoba, and shall be payable at the Stonewall Branch of the Sunova Credit Union Ltd. in Stonewall Manitoba and shall be dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December A. D., 2008.
- 5. That the said borrowing shall bear interest at a rate estimated for the time being at 6 % per annum, and subject in any event to the authorization of The Municipal Board at the time of sale, and shall mature in accordance with the maturities set out in Schedule "A" hereto on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December in each of the years 2009 to 2028, both inclusive.
- 6. That the issuance of borrowings shall be signed by the Mayor, or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign same, and by the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Stonewall and there shall be affixed thereto the corporate seal of the Town of Stonewall.
- 7. That during the currency of the said borrowing; namely, in each of the years 2009 to 2028, both inclusive, there shall be raised annually by a special mill rate on all the rateable property within the Town of Stonewall, an amount sufficient to meet the requirement for principal and interest.
- 8. That pursuant to subsection 174(3)(d) of The Municipal Act, pending the issue of the borrowing, the Council of The Town of Stonewall may agree with a bank or person or borrow from the general funds of the Town for temporary advances from time to time to meet expenditures incurred for the purpose aforesaid, and the total of such advances shall not exceed **Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00)**.
- 9. That during the term of the borrowing authorized herein, in any year where the debt remains unissued, the levies may be made as if the borrowing had been issued; and upon completion of the Project authorized herein, the levies shall be applied in reduction of temporary financing, and when issued, the amount and term of borrowing shall be reduced accordingly.

# TOWN OF STONEWALL By-law No. 14/09

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 7/09 which provides for the expenditure and borrowing of funds for the construction of the Quarry Park Heritage Arts Centre

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Stonewall has duly passed By-law No. 7/09 which was authorized by Municipal Board Order No. E-09-107, is inter alia, authorized to issue borrowing in the amount of \$1,000,000.00;

**AND WHEREAS**, the estimated total cost of the Project has increased from \$4,000,000.00 to \$6,700,000.00 and the Town of Stonewall has approval of increased funding from grants, reserves and transfers from \$3,000,000 to \$5,700,000.00;

# **TOWN OF STONEWALL - BY-LAW NO. 07/09**

The Town of Stonewall (the "Town") submits By-law No. 07/09 under Section 176 of *The Municipal Act*.

By-law No. 07/09, attached as Appendix "A" proposes the construction of the Visitor Centre at the Stonewall Quarry Park. The estimated cost of the project is \$4,000,000.00. The Town is to receive funding from the Insurance Claim (original Centre destroyed by fire in 2007) and from Community Contributions in the amount of \$250,000.00. The balance of \$1,000,000.00 is to be borrowed by the Town.

Upon considering the proposed By-law, THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Town of Stonewall By-law No. 07/09 **BE APPROVED** subject to the following amendments:
  - (a) In the fourth "Whereas" Clause, delete "\$3,250,000.00" and replace with "\$1,000,000.00";
  - (b) In Clause No. 1, delete "expand up to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00)" and replace with "expend up to Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00)";
  - (c) In Clause No. 4, delete "2009" and replace with "2008";
  - (d) In Clause No. 5, delete "2010 to 2029" and replace with "2009 to 2028"; and
  - (e) In Clause No. 7, delete "2029" and replace with "2028".

2. A filing fee of \$50.00 be paid by the Town of Stonewall.

By-law No. 7/09

Being a By-law to provide for the expenditure and borrowing of funds for the construction of the Quarry Park Visitor Centre

WHEREAS, The Municipal Act, S.M. 1996, c.58 provides, in part, as follows:

"172 In this Division,

"borrowing" means the borrowing of money, and includes (e) issuing debentures

"borrowing by-law" means a by-law referred to in Subsection 174 (1) (a)."

"174 (1) A municipality may make a borrowing only if

- (a) the borrowing is authorized by by-law; and
- (b) subject to subsection (2), the borrowing is set out as a debt obligation in the operating budget or capital budget or it is made to fund an expenditure authorized under subsection 169(5).

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Stonewall is of the opinion that the following project, being:

the construction of the Visitor Centre at Stonewall Quarry Park for the provision of interpretive, educational, community, performing and visual arts and administrative services and programs.

should be undertaken within the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS**, the total cost of the Project is estimated at \$4,000,000.00 and the Town of Stonewall is expecting funding from grants, reserves and transfers in the amount of \$3,000,000.00;

**AND WHEREAS**, in order to complete such undertakings, it will be necessary for the Town of Stonewall to borrow the sum of \$3,250,000.00 as hereinafter provided, which is the amount of the debt intended to be created by this By-law;

AND WHEREAS, the consecutive annual amounts, including principal and interest, required to be raised each year for twenty (20) years, as hereinafter provided, for paying the principal and interest under this By-law are the amounts set out in Schedule "A" hereto;

**AND WHEREAS**, the assessed value of the whole land chargeable under this By-law, according to the last revised assessment roll, is \$117,246,370.00;

**AND WHEREAS** the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Town of Stonewall is \$3,040,628.67, of which no portion of the principal or of the interest thereon is in arrears;

- 1. That the Town of Stonewall may expand up to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) for the purposes of the Project;
- 2. That the Town of Stonewall is hereby authorized and empowered to raise upon the credit of the municipality, funds not repayable within the current fiscal year by the

borrowing of money in an amount not exceeding **One Million Dollars** (\$1,000,000.00).

3. That the funds so raised shall be for the purpose of financing certain works as follows:

the construction of the Visitor Centre at Stonewall Quarry Park for the provision of interpretive, educational, community, performing and visual arts and administrative services and programs.

- 4. That borrowing for the aforesaid Project shall be issued by the Town of Stonewall in the Province of Manitoba, and shall be payable at the Stonewall Branch of the Sunova Credit Union Ltd. in Stonewall Manitoba and shall be dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December A. D., 2009.
- 5. That the said borrowing shall bear interest at a rate estimated for the time being at 6 % per annum, and subject in any event to the authorization of The Municipal Board at the time of sale, and shall mature in accordance with the maturities set out in Schedule "A" hereto on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December in each of the years 2010 to 2029, both inclusive.
- 6. That the issuance of borrowings shall be signed by the Mayor, or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign same, and by the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Stonewall and there shall be affixed thereto the corporate seal of the Town of Stonewall.
- 7. That during the currency of the said borrowing; namely, in each of the years 2009 to 2029, both inclusive, there shall be raised annually by a special mill rate on all the rateable property within the Town of Stonewall, an amount sufficient to meet the requirement for principal and interest.
- 8. That pursuant to subsection 174(3)(d) of The Municipal Act, pending the issue of the borrowing, the Council of The Town of Stonewall may agree with a bank or person or borrow from the general funds of the Town for temporary advances from time to time to meet expenditures incurred for the purpose aforesaid, and the total of such advances shall not exceed **Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00)**.
- 9. That during the term of the borrowing authorized herein, in any year where the debt remains unissued, the levies may be made as if the borrowing had been issued; and upon completion of the Project authorized herein, the levies shall be applied in reduction of temporary financing, and when issued, the amount and term of borrowing shall be reduced accordingly.

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 7/09 which provides for the expenditure and borrowing of funds for the construction of the Quarry Park Heritage Arts Centre

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Stonewall has duly passed By-law No. 7/09 being a by-law to provide for the expenditure and borrowing of funds for the construction of the Quarry Park Heritage Arts Centre;

AND WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the Project has increased from \$4,000,000.00 to \$6,700,000.00 as the Town of Stonewall is expecting funding from grants, reserves and transfers in the amount of \$5,700,000,00:
