**BACKGROUND/INTENT:**

To develop guidelines for the annual appointments to the various Boards and Committees.

**POLICY/PROCEDURES:**

1. The Mayor shall, annually, prior to the first regular meeting of Council each year, review the list of appointments to the various Boards and Committees and make recommendations to Council for appointments to the Boards and Committees for the next one year period.
2. The list of Boards and Committees shall, after adoption by Council at the first regular meeting of Council each year, be attached hereto as Schedule "A" to Policy No. 1. 2.
